I am a regular user of biodiesel and always use B100 except in colder conditions. I have been using B100 for last few years via the biodiesel station in sydney. There have no negative impacts on my vehicle at all and indeed I feel that my engine runs smoother and quieter. I have no problems with damage to paint work or seals etc.

In view of the heightening problems with fossil based fuels , I feel it would be very in appropriate to limit biofuel blends to minimal levels. I don't know of any reported incidents of damage caused to vehicles using B100 and all reactions in the biodiesel forums and the community at large seem positive.

Obvioulsy strict controls are required to ensure meets Australian Fuel standards, but limiting blends to small amounts of biodiesel may drive more people to try and produce their own product, which would not be desired.

So I would to voice my opinion that I disagree with the idea of limiting biodeisel supply to the general public to lower levels and maintain that the choice of B100 should be available to those who wish to purchase it
