APPLICATION FOR AN ESSENTIAL USES LICENCE TO MANUFACTURE, IMPORT AND/OR EXPORT CHLOROFLUOROCARBONS, HALONS, METHYL CHLOROFORM, CARBON TETRACHLORIDE AND BROMOCHLOROMETHANE *

THIS LICENCE APPLICATION FORM RELATES TO THE PERIOD

1 JANUARY 2008 – 31 DECEMBER 2008

*Under the Montreal Protocol, the manufacture, import and export of CFC, halon, methyl chloroform and carbon tetrachloride substances ceased on 31 December 1995, while the manufacture, import and export of bromochloromethane ceased on 24 February 2002 except where the Parties to the Montreal Protocol have approved continued import, export or manufacture for an essential use.

LICENCE FEE

Licences may not be granted by the Minister until the prescribed licence application fee of \$3,000 (no GST applies) has been received and cleared by the Commonwealth. The fee can either be paid by cheque made out to the Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage, and the Arts and submitted with this licence application form or by electronic funds transfer with a Remittance Advice notice attached to the Application. The fee is payable for each licence period or part thereof.

Licensee information may be published in the Government Gazette Notices in March and September each year.

It is an offence under section 62 of the Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Act 1989 to provide a document that contains information that is false or misleading information in a material particular.
