APPLICATION FOR QUOTA

Subsection 31(2) of the *Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Act 1989* provides that the base year for an HCFC quota period in which quotas are allocated is the penultimate calendar year before the start of that quota period. The next quota period is 2008-2009. HCFC quotas will therefore be allocated based on regulated HCFC activities carried out by individual licensees during 2006.

Regulated activities are defined under the *Ozone Protection and Synthetic Greenhouse Gas Management Act 1989* as the import and manufacture of HCFCs.

For the purposes of calculating quotas, the amount of HCFCs, other than HCFC 141B, taken to have been imported is the gross amount less 5% heel deduction for refillable containers greater than

nominal one tonne. (Note that HCFC 141B is not considered to be a gas at room temperature, and therefore a heel allowance cannot be deducted for that substance).
