#### Application to amend the List of Specimens Suitable for Live Import (Live Import List)

A person may apply to amend the List of Specimens Suitable for Live Import (Live Import List) to include an item under section 303EE of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) and Regulation 9A.07 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Regulations 2001*.

The Live Import List is comprised of two parts:

Part 1 – specimens not requiring an import permit

Part 2 – specimens that require an import permit

Any specimens not on the Live Import List cannot be imported into Australia.

#### Who should fill out this form

Any person wishing to apply to amend the Live Import List under the EPBC Act needs to complete this form.

#### Important Notes

- Applications will not be accepted without
  - I. completion of the applicant details and a signed declaration
  - II. a draft risk assessment report addressing the Terms of Reference
- There are severe penalties for knowingly making false or misleading statements in this application.
- Most imports of live animals require clearance or a permit from the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service (AQIS). Please contact AQIS in your state or territory for information on quarantine and health control.
- Each state and territory of Australia has different legislation regarding legally keeping different species so it is advisable to check what restrictions may be imposed where you reside.
