**DETERMINATION PROHIBITING USE OF COMMERCIAL FISHING
VESSELS IN COD GROUNDS COMMONWEALTH MARINE RESERVE**

I, ANNEMARIE WATT, Acting Assistant Secretary, Marine Conservation Branch, Department of the Environment and Water Resources, delegate of the power of the Director of National Parks under subregulation 12.56(2) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Regulations 2000* hereby determine that the use of commercial fishing vessels in the area of water known as the Cod Grounds Commonwealth Marine Reserve, being the area specified in the Schedule hereto, is prohibited at all times.

SCHEDULE

All of that area in the Tasman Sea enclosed within the circumference of a circle of radius 1000 metres the centre of which is at the point of latitude 31 degrees 40 minutes 52 seconds south, longitude 152 degrees 54 minutes 37 seconds east.*

* All geographic coordinates are expressed in terms of the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94) as defined in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette GN35 of 6 September 1995.
