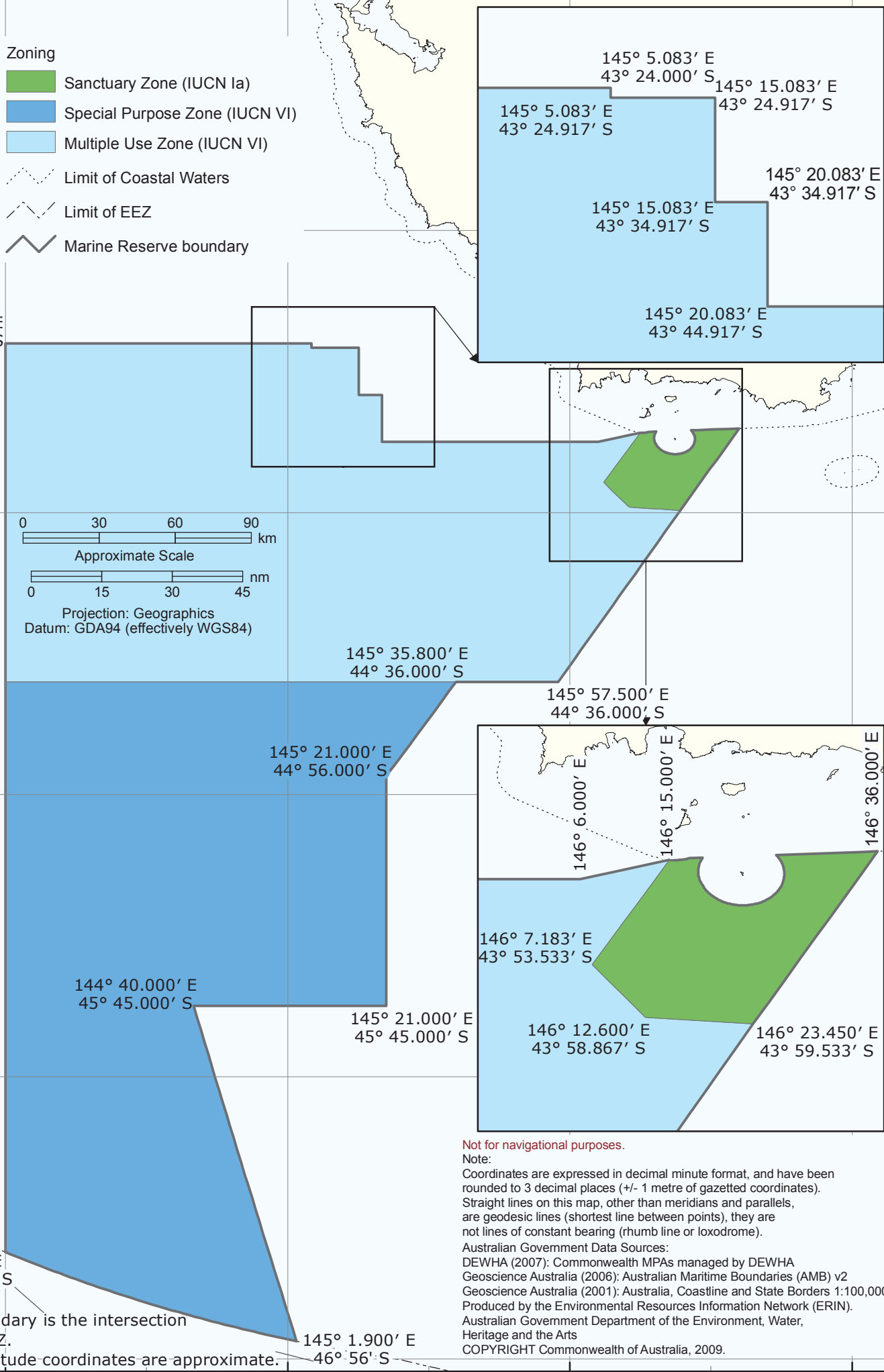
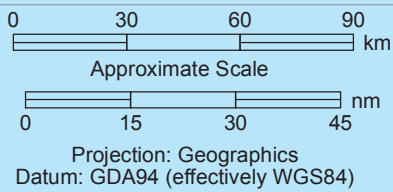


Tasman Fracture Commonwealth Marine Reserve
