The Australian Whale Sanctuary provides protection for whales within Australian waters. The Sanctuary extends to 200 nautical miles from Australia's coast and territorial islands. The Sanctuary is legally enforceable under federal environment law. Australian jurisdiction over the Antarctic waters is not universally recognised.
