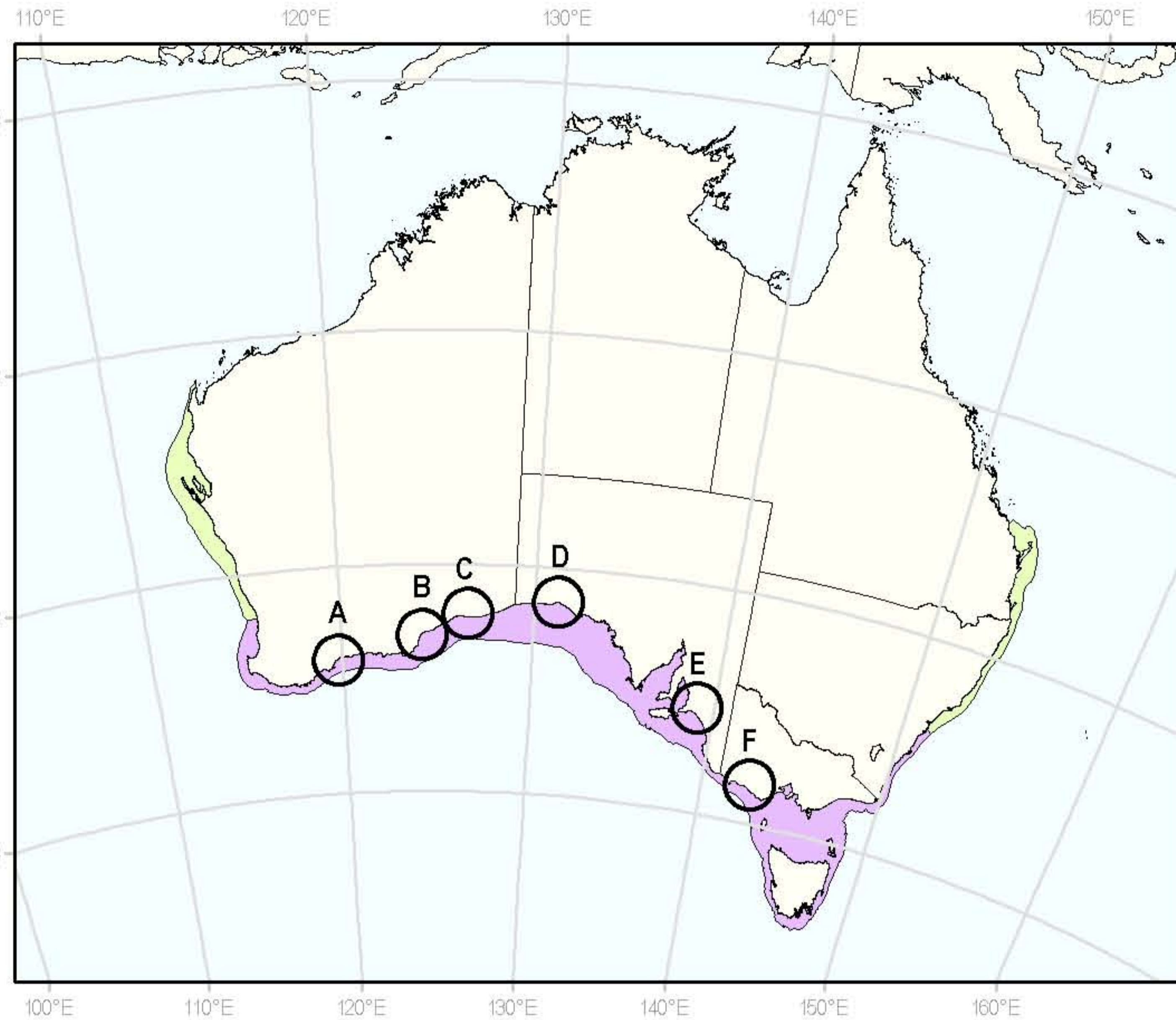


**Figure 1: Distribution and recognised aggregation areas of the southern right whale**
