



Notification of Possession, Custody or Control of a Historic Shipwreck Relic

Under Sections 9 and 10(1) of the Commonwealth Historic Shipwrecks Act 1976

Important Note: This notification must be provided to the agency (see overleaf) for the State or Territory in which the relic is located, within 30 days of coming into possession, custody and control of the relic.

Additional details if the relics are held by a business, association or government entity

Form with fields for Name and ABN.

Details if the possession, custody or control is the result of a transfer of possession

Form with fields for Permit number and Date of transfer.

Description of relic (Include photographs or digital images of the relic where possible)

Table with 4 columns: Registered number (If registered), Type of object (coin, anchor, bottle etc), Features (markings, writing, design etc), and Dimensions (length, width, height, weight). Dimensions are further divided into L, H, W, and weight.

Series of text boxes for questions: Where was the relic found or acquired?, Which historic shipwreck is the relic associated with (Fill in details below if known)?, Name of shipwreck:, National Shipwrecks Database ID number:, In which State or Territory is the historic shipwreck relic currently located?, Where is the relic stored?, How is the relic stored?, and What is the condition of the relic?.
