## HABITATS

<b>puṭi</b>	Rock outcrops, boulders, scree slopes and associated watercourses.
<b>karu</b>	Creeks (usually dry) and and outwash plains.
<b>aripita</b>	Low shrublands on alluvial fans, dominated by cassias.
<b>tjintjira</b>	Claypans occasionally inundated with water.
<b>puṭi</b>	Shrublands on red loamy soil, usually dominated by mulga.
<b>altarpa</b>	Sandy country dominated by <i>Eucalyptus</i> mallee.
<b>tali</b>	Sand dune crests and upper slopes.
<b>pila</b>	Sand plains and lower dune slopes, usually dominated by spinifex and desert oak.
<b>nyaru</b>	Sand plain country which has been burnt in the last five or so years.
<b>urilpa</b>	Stony plains and low hills with little vegetation.
